Stamford Innovation Week: Cultivating Unexpected Opportunities for Growth

Stamford, Conn (August 20, 2018)—The region's most enterprising minds will gather at venues across the city September 13-23, 2018, for Stamford Innovation Week (SiW), an event series designed to connect entrepreneurs, tech talent and investors and create unexpected opportunities for growth.
